

# Gokyo Renjo La Pass Trek

## Trip Overview

Gokyo Lake and Renjo La Pass trekking are the most popular, challenging, and amazing trekking in the Everest region of Nepal. The journey to Gokyo Lake Trek is a classic Himalayan detour to explore nature and culture in Solukhumbu, Nepal. Highland Eco Trek takes trekkers to the top of the Gokyo Ri and sees the Langur Himalayan range, which includes four of the eight thousand highest peaks in the world. Relish the jaw-dropping scenery of mountains and an alluring valley with beautiful glaciers and lakes surrounding Gokyo Valley.

Most trekkers have a dream of being at Everest Base Camp, but Gokyo Valley has the most amazing view of the Himalayas and landscape and is less crowded. Gokyo Lake, sandwiched between Renjo La and Chola Pass, is trekking with Mt. Choyou on the backdrop of Gokyo Lake, also known as Dhud Kund. The trails follow upwards to Phakding on the bank of the Dhudkosi River, which is coming from Gokyo Lake. After reaching the town of Namche Bazaar, the trekkers take a different route than the Everest base camp trek through a green, lush forest to reach Gokyo Lake. After crossing the Renjo La pass, you can see the valley landscape and the local Sherpa people in Thame village.

The time spent at the shores of Gokyo Lake is mind-blowing. Clear Himalayan water and a tranquil environment will make you feel relaxed and rejuvenated. Join the Gokyo Lake Trek package with the Highland Eco Trek family. You will be amazed to find out the interesting wonders of Mother Nature during the enthralling Gokyo Renjo La pass trekking in Nepal.

**Day 1: Pick up from airport transfer to Hotel**

## Cost Includes

- 3-star hotel accommodation in Kathmandu with breakfast ( hotel standard will be changed as you wish).

- The teahouse twins shared basic accommodations during the trek.
- Domestic flights as per the itinerary.
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner during the trek.
- An experienced, English-speaking, and government-licensed trekking guide.
- Porter service (2 trekkers: 1 porter).
- Trekking crew, including their salary, insurance, equipment, domestic airfare, food, and

accommodation.

- Highland Eco's duffel bag.
- All necessary paperwork and trekking permits (National Park Permit, Village Development Committee fee).
- A first-aid safety kit with basic medicines is essential.
- All government and local taxes and fees.

## **Cost Excludes**

- Nepal Entry visa fees
- Extra-night accommodation in Kathmandu because of early arrival, late departure, or early return from the mountain (due to any reason) compared to the scheduled itinerary
- Lunch and evening meals in Kathmandu
- International flights
- Personal trekking equipment, which is not provided by Highland Eco-Trek
- Travel and rescue insurance
- Tips to the guide, porter, driver, or any other trekking staff
