

Gosaikunda Helambu Trek

Trip Overview

Gosaikunda Helambu trek is a way to get the blended flavor of mountainous views and a taste of the authentic culture of Nepal. Mostly inhabited by the Tamang community, the tradition and way of life are mostly influenced by Tibetan culture. Thus, the accommodation during the trek is in teahouses or lodges. The trek is simple, as hiking up and down involves the same routine as other trekking routes, but encountering the lively community brightens the feel of the trek. Together with that, the unique flora and fauna are another interesting part of this trek. The Tamang Heritage Trail Trek and the Langtang Valley Trek also lie in the Langtang and Helambu Regions.

Gosaikunda Lake itself is a beautiful place, flaunting its tranquility. Religiously, Gosaikunda Lake is very important for Hindus, as it is the place where the fight between God and Demon takes place to drink the holy water. The magnificent view of the snowcapped mountains, lakes, and clear, beautiful sky makes the trek worth every step you take to reach there. Besides that, get insights into the locals and their culture, tradition, and way of life. Also, they get lost in the dense rhododendron forest and the cascading waterfalls.

Cost Includes

- pickups and drops in a private vehicle at the Airport upon your arrival and departure
- All ground transportation on a comfortable private vehicle as per the itinerary
- 3-star hotel accommodation in Kathmandu with breakfast (hotel standard will be changed as you wish)
- The Kathmandu Sightseeing Tour is inclusive of all entry fees, a tour guide, and a private vehicle as per the itinerary.

- Personal trekking equipment, which is not provided by Highland Eco-Trek
- Travel and rescue insurance
