

Upper Dolpo Jomsom Trek

Trip Overview

The upper Dolpo Trek takes you to the far western region of Nepal. The Dolpo district lies in the Karnali province. The area is a remote and secluded area of Nepal. Trekking in the Dolpo region can be challenging. There is no proper development of any infrastructure. You can explore the magnificent high Himalayan valleys, rugged trails, and unique culture of distant, far-west Nepal. This can be an experience for a lifetime. The landscape of the Dolpo resembles the Tibetan plateau. Trekking in the Dolpo region gives you an intellectual feeling of being in the wilderness.

The Shey Phokshundo Lake lies in the central part of the region. The lake is also the deepest in Nepal. A large portion of the area is covered by Sheyphokshundo National Park. The national park shelters a variety of flora and fauna. It is also home to endangered flora and fauna. The oldest Shey monastery is also part of this trek. The influence of Tibetan Buddhist culture can be seen in this region and is also the main highlight of this trek. The gorgeous Dhaulagiri and the Churi Himal ranges surround the east, west, and south of the Dolpo region. Thus, the magnificent view of Dhaulagiri, the Chure Himal range, and the snowy peaks are the backdrop throughout the journey.

Trekking in this area compulsorily needs a special kind of permit. Therefore, you cannot travel independently on the trail. The number of teahouses is limited; you may need to carry a tent too. Trekking in this area can be challenging, but it is all worth it when you encounter the Himalayan valleys, quaint Lake Phoshundo, lush vegetation, and the unique culture of this area.

Trip Itinerary

Day 1: Pick up from airport transfer to Hotel

Cost Includes

- 3-star hotel accommodation in Kathmandu with breakfast (the hotel standard will be changed as you wish).

- Accommodation is in a tent house during the trek.

- All necessary paperwork and trekking permits ('Restricted Areas' Permit, National Park Permit, ACAP, TIMS).
- A first-aid safety kit with basic medicines is essential.
- All government and local taxes and fees.

Cost Excludes

- Nepal Entry visa fees
- Extra-night accommodation in Kathmandu because of early arrival, late departure, or early return from the mountain (due to any reason) compared to the scheduled itinerary
- Meals not indicated in the City
- International flights
- Personal equipment (a suggested list will be mailed to you)
- Travel and rescue insurance **(Required)**
- Tips to the guide, porter, driver, or any other trekking staff
- Other expenses of a personal nature.
