Trip Overview

The Five Lakes Trek, which is called Panch Pokhari in Nepali, lies to the north-east of Kathmandu. The word "Panch" means five in Nepali, and "Pokahari" means ponds in Nepali, giving the ultimate name Panch Pokhari. Panch Pokhari is a sanctified place for Hindu and Buddhist followers. The place is largely visited by devotees during Janai Purnima, which is a religiously important festival that falls in the month of August.PanchPokhari (Five Lake) Trek is a recently opened trekking trail that offers a full doze of thrills and adventurous treks. Wander around the woods and get lost in the stunning beauty of the five serene lakes.

The Five Lakes Trek begins in Kathmandu after a guided tour of the UNESCO-listed world heritage sites in the Kathmandu valley. The trek is completely mesmerizing, as the trail is not overly crowded, unlike other trekking regions of Nepal. Therefore, you will find most of the trail to yourself and, as a companion, the sound of the chirping birds, your breath, and the remarkable sound of the flowing rapids of rivers. Besides that, explore the local village's mostly-inhabited Tamang and Sherpa communities. Explore their unique Tibetan Buddhist-influenced culture, tradition, and customs. The Five Lakes Trek is all about the exploration of the devotion of people towards their respective gods as well as discovering the authentic clash of nature and culture.

- Lunch and evening meals in Kathmandu
- International flights
