BhairavKunda is largely visited on the Janai Purnima, which is one of the important festivals in Nepal. Bhairav Kunda, which lies in the Rasuwa district, is naturally blessed with hundreds of placid ponds. After several days of hiking and passing many charming villages, you will reach Bhairav Kunda.

The trek to BhairavKunda is not hard but will require a day or two of acclimatization due to the high altitude. Other than that, it is absolutely fun, thrilling, and full of adventure treks in Nepal, among many other trekking destinations in Nepal. The panoramic views of the Dorjelakpa (6966m), Jugal Himal, Madiya, and many more, along with other Tibetan Himalayas, are pure bliss to the sore eyes.
