Trip Overview

The Dhaulagiri Trek is an astonishing journey to explore the unexplored grandeur of the Dhaulagiri massif. The trail to Dhaulagiri Base Camp is off-beaten and also a challenging trek. The seventh-highest mountain in the world, Mt. Dhaulagiri, maybe one of your dream destinations. The view of the snow-clad mountains and the massive glaciers is a sight for sore eyes. As there are white mountains to adore and capture with your camera, the Dhaulagiri trek is also about knowing the culture and passing through the terraced farmlands, small wooden bridges, green forests, and beloved untamed rivers.

The Dhaulagiri massif stretches from the Kaligandaki River to the west of Bheri. Dhaulagiri I is the seventh-highest mountain in the world. Since the trail to the Dhaulagiri massif is remote and off-beaten, the accommodation and the food are modest and simple. Likewise, the trek is comparatively hard, so the trek is fit for the fit and trekking enthusiast. A high level of endurance is very much needed to face the harsh and cold environment. The trek starts in Kathmandu, taking you to the secluded and far-flung region where you will get a chance to relish the natural beauty of Dhaulagiri Massif.
