

Api Base Camp Nampa Valley Trek

Trip Overview

Api Base Camp Nampa Valley trekking is an off-beaten-path trek in the far-western part of Nepal, in the district of Darchula. The valley is naturally stunning and untouched by any kind of modernization. Unlike other parts of the region, the growth of tourism in Darchula is slower than the rest. Despite being a remote area, the trek in this region is truly beautiful, even with the limited number of facilities like accommodation, transportation, health, and many more. Api Nampa Conservation Area is the newest conservation area in Nepal. Therefore, traffic in this region for trekking is much less than in other conservation areas like Annapurna and Everest, but still as remarkable as in other places.

The journey to Api Nampa Valley is at least a two-week journey. The trek is quite difficult since it is off the Beaten Path. However, you will be delighted by the glorious sight of the Himalayas, amazing landscapes, deep gorges, and lush forests and be exposed to the culture, tradition, and way of life of the people living in this region. The tea houses are cheaper than the other trekking places in Nepal and offer only a limited number of meal plans. Come along with the Highland Eco Trek and see the utmost beauty of one of the isolated parts of Nepal.

Trip Itinerary

Day 1: Pick up from airport transfer to Hotel

- A first-aid safety kit with basic medicines is essential.
- All government and local taxes and fees.

Cost Excludes

- Nepal Entry visa fees
- Extra-night accommodation in Kathmandu because of early arrival, late departure, and early return from the mountain (due to any reason) than the scheduled itinerary
- Lunch and evening meals in Kathmandu
- International flights
- Personal trekking equipment, which is not provided by Highland Eco
- Travel and rescue insurance
- Tips to the guide, porter, driver, or any other trekking staff
