

Limi Valley Trek

Trip Overview

Limi Valley Trek is one of the most remote parts of Nepal, escorting absolutely beautiful landscapes, mountains, and vibrant culture. Limi Valley lies in the northern part of the Humla District of Nepal. The district is more known among trekkers who have trekked through the region on the way to Mt. Kailash and Mansarovar. Limi Valley is situated between two high passes, Hilsa and Chang La. Though Limi Valley is remote in terms of development, it is rewarding in both aspects of culture and scenery. Therefore, the culture and natural beauty are intact in their actual form. As trekking in Nepal is quite famous, rather than trekking on the busy trails, the Limi Valley trek is the perfect alternative for those who would love to walk through the less crowded path yet still get the magnificent views of the mountains and nature and meet the friendly herds while on the journey.

Limi Valley is an interesting and beautiful place. The fortress-like stone villages within the Limi Valley are undoubtedly the main attraction of the trek. Not only that, but the amazing landscapes and openly grazing sheep make the trek more fun and exciting. Also, walking through the open landscapes, glacial valleys, charming little villages, and over the rides makes the trek more thrilling. In addition, get to know the fading Bon tradition. Bon tradition is only practiced in a few parts of Nepal thus, the tradition is about to have vanished. The ancient gompas and monasteries add more glory to the trek. The Buddhist religion is more prevalent in this area so you may get to see the prayer flags, stupas, and mani walls throughout the trek. The trek is worthwhile as the galore views of snow-capped mountains like Mt. Saipal, Mt. Kailash, Kanjirowa, Kanti, and other Himalayan ranges can be seen.
