## Trip Itinerary

### Day 1: Everest Heli Tour

05:30 AM - 6:30 AM: The International Airport in Kathmandu is the starting point for your Everest helicopter tour. We will collect you from the hotel early in the morning and take you to the domestic terminal of the airport.

06:30 AM - 7:00 AM: You will receive assistance from your guide with luggage and check-in. Make sure your tickets and passport are with you. You will be prepared to board the aircraft for Lukla once an airport official has reviewed your paperwork and ticket.

07:00 AM - 8:00 AM: After completing the necessary formalities at the airport, you are scheduled to depart for Lukla. Fantastic views of verdant hills will greet you as you take off, and you will pass past Dolakha hamlet before arriving at Jiri village. The heli flight continues over the 3,550-meter-high Lamjura-La Pass, which is blanketed in dense rhododendron trees.

You will arrive at Lukla, with stunning views of the Himalayan mountain ranges, 45 minutes later. At 2,820 meters above sea level, Lukla is located. The runway at Lukla Airport is the smallest in the world.

08:00 AM-8:15 AM: You will begin to experience the local Sherpa way of life as soon as you land in Lukla. There are a lot of Sherpa guides and porters at the airport who are waiting for their customers. Refueling the aircraft will take about fifteen minutes.

08:15 AM-8:30 AM: You are ready to fly to Kala Patthar after refuelling at the airport in Lukla. You can find out your exact location, be it the powerful Khumbu glacier or the fabled Everest Base Camp, thanks to the in-flight commentary. As you fly above the Kala Patthar in the second half of the flight, you will be treated to fantastic vistas of mountains including Pumori, Everest, and the peak of Lhotse.

08:30 AM-8:45 AM: There's more to this helicopter tour than just flying overhead and staring at the amazing scenery. The three- to four-hour Everest Helicopter Tour lands you in Kalapatthar, where you may take in the breathtaking vista of the massive, majestic peaks of Nepal's Khumbu region. Although fifteen minutes on the ground might not seem like much, it's enough time to discover breathtaking vistas of the picturesque mountain scenery.

08:45 AM-9:00 AM: Your guide will be with you the entire time as you soar across the mountains, providing you with all the information you require about the sights you can see from above while the vivid hues of a paradisiacal sunrise meld together. Your hunger for another helicopter tour will be piqued after this little flight.

Following your enchanted stay at Kala Patthar, you will take a flight to the Everest View Hotel, which is the highest hotel in the world, where you will enjoy a substantial breakfast. The flight provides breathtaking views of the Everest region's snow-capped peaks, monasteries, Chortens, Gorak Shep, and Khumbu Glacier.

09:00 AM-9:30 AM: Syangboche is well-known for its Everest View Hotel, which is well-known for offering views of Mount Everest from every angle. This place is perfect for enjoying the breathtaking view of snow-capped peaks in luxury. At the magnificent Everest View Hotel, you will enjoy a substantial and satisfying breakfast.

09:30 AM-10:30 AM: With breathtaking views of the Himalayas, you will fly back to Lukla after enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel. Nothing is more thrilling than a close-up, unobstructed view of the Himalayas from above. The aircraft will land at Lukla once more for a fifteen-minute stopover to refuel before returning to Kathmandu.

10:00 AM-11:00 AM: Lastly, you will get a final glimpse of the diversity of the Everest region landscapes as you gaze down on Namche Bazaar, Lukla, and Phakding before returning to Kathmandu. You will be driven back to your accommodation in a comfortable, private vehicle following this thrilling flight.
