Trip Overview

Entering the lively village of Sikles, a little but densely populated community home to various ethnic groups, chiefly Gurungs, marks the start of the experience. You embark on a multi-day hike from Sikles to explore the captivating Kapuche Lake, a magnificent glacier lake tucked away in an incredible setting. You follow your route to Kori Danda, the crown jewel after you have had time to relax and take in the peaceful surroundings of Kapuche Lake. At 3800 meters above sea level, Kori Danda provides unmatched panoramic views of the nearby natural beauties. Kori Danda is not like tall mountains; instead, it's a charming hill covered in brilliant flowers and verdant meadows. Those who rise early are rewarded with a strange scene of hazy clouds enveloping their surroundings. Not to mention their breathtaking show of golden-hued sunrises and sunsets that beautify this enchanted location.

From Kori Hill, a quick walk gets you to Nyamla Pass, which serves as the entrance to Manang, one of Nepal's most popular trekking destinations. Having enjoyed the peace of Kori Hill, the journey downhill to Tangting takes you through the interesting settlements of Kolashotar. The Gurung ethnic group is said to have originated in Sota, and the area is still dotted with the remains of old palaces that existed hundreds of years ago. The road drops steadily till it reaches Tangting, the conclusion point of this incredible adventure.

The Annapurna region's remarkable and lesser-known trekking path is the Kori Hill Trek. It provides a special chance to enjoy the beauty of the surrounding landscape while embracing isolation. Knowing that the Highland Eco Trek team is your reliable guide means that you are in the capable hands of people with extensive experience and familiarity with this less-travelled route. Trip Itinerary

Day 1: Pick up from airport transfer to the Hotel

Day 2: After breakfast join the heritage tour sightseeing

After breakfast, we start our journey through four stunning UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These incorporate the structurally rich Durbar Square, the holy Hindu sanctuary of Pashupati Nath, and the Buddha Nath Stupa, which is one of the biggest stupas on the planet. After finishing our visit late in the evening, we drove to the hotel to become more acquainted with our group pioneer (guide) and kindred explorers.

Day 3: Flight or Drive to Pokhara

Pokhara is a well-known travel destination that can be found along the road that parallels the Marsyangdi and Trisuli rivers in the scenic Kashik District. The trip leads to a lovely stream for boating and breathtaking views of the Ganesh Himal and Manaslu crests. With its lakes, caves, and Buddhist and Hindu sanctuaries, Pokhara is a tourist's paradise. Guests are welcome to spend the night at their hotel after a six-hour drive from Kathmandu (200 km).

- Day 4: Drive to Siklesh village and evening explore Gurung village
- Day 5: Trek to Hugu Goth camp
- Day 6: Trek to Kapuche Lake and back to Goth camp
- Day 7: Trek to Nohtaha camp
- Day 8: Trek to Kori hill
- Day 9: Morning Explore Kori then trek down to Tasa camp
- Day 10: Trek to Tangting gurung village
- Day 11: Drive to Pokhara
- Day 12: Drive / Flight to Kathmandu
- **Day 13: Fly your Destination**

Cost Includes

- Pickups and drops you off in a private vehicle at the Airport upon your arrival and departure
- All ground transportation on a comfortable private vehicle as per the itinerary
